

ALAIEDON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES
Monday, July 12, 2021

The regular Alaiedon Township Board meeting held Monday; July 12, 2021 was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Supervisor Steven Lott. Members present: Supervisor Steven Lott, Treasurer Scott Everett, Trustee Kurt Kranz, Trustee Beth Smith, and Deputy Clerk Virginia Coffman. Clerk David Leonard was absent.

Deputy Jacob Dell was also in attendance.

Motion by Smith, supported by Everett, to approve the minutes of the June 28, 2021 meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Motion by Kranz, supported by Smith, to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.

Deputy Jacob Dell attended the meeting to introduce himself as being assigned to Alaiedon Township.

He reported on the continued problem with the theft of catalytic converters. The Board discussed the concern of semis still parking on James Phillips Drive now that it has been posted for no parking. He was given the Alaiedon Township Parking Ordinance and the sections of the zoning ordinance pertaining to marihuana regulation. There is a concern about several locations in the Township. The Board thanked Deputy Dell for coming to the meeting.

Supervisor Lott discussed the proposal he has received for a proposed Midwest Power Equipment about location in Alaiedon Township. It was determined that a Special Land Use Permit would be required.

Motion by Smith, supported by Kranz, to approve the sign proposal of 34.44 sq ft for the Jersey Mike's location at 3490 Okemos Road, Okemos. Motion carried.

Motion by Everett, supported by Smith, to pay the following invoices: General Fund check #10586 through #10492 and nine electronic transfers in the amount of \$16,294.06. Tax Account one electronic transfer in the amount of \$3,889.70. Motion carried.

Motion by Smith, supported by Kranz, to adjourn. Motion carried at 8:50 p.m.
